# Scams Defined



## What is a Scam?



Scam describes any fraudulent business or scheme that takes money or other goods from an unsuspecting person. As the world becomes more connected via the Internet, online scams have increased significantly.

## Signs of a Scam

One or more of the following can be a sign of a scam:

- Unsolicited contact
- Emergency or urgent action needed
- Unconventional payments
- Requests for personal information
- Secrecy

## Pandemic Scams

Scammers use COVID related issues to steal your money and/or information:

- Government imposters
- Fraudulent cures or medical equipment
- Quarantine resources
- Unemployment benefits
- Stimulus payments
- Job opportunities

## Fake Cures

- Ignore offers for vaccinations, miracle treatments, or cures
- Real contact tracers and scammers
- Be wary of ads for test kits
- Watch for emails claiming to be from the CDC or WHO
- Avoid fraud

It is the act or instance of charging customers too high a price for goods or services, especially when demand is high and supplies are limited.
