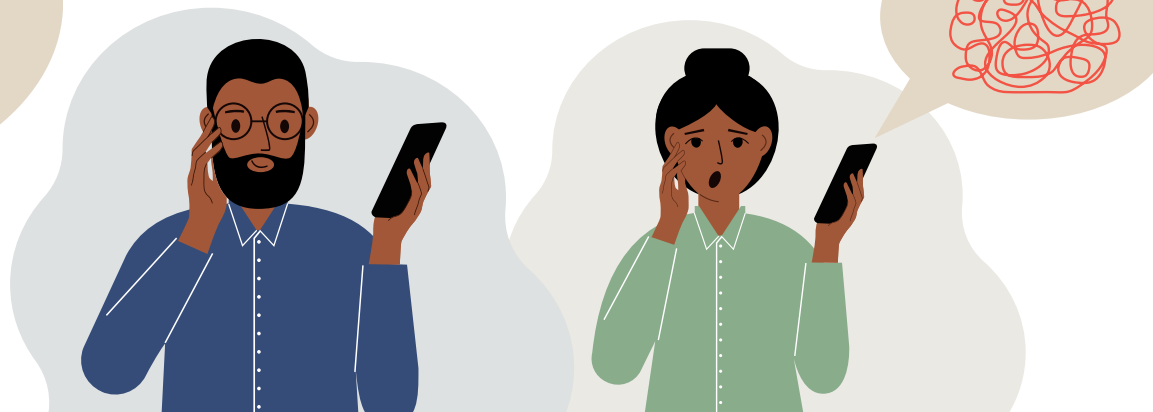
Share your story with one of our community advocates who will fill out a report for you.

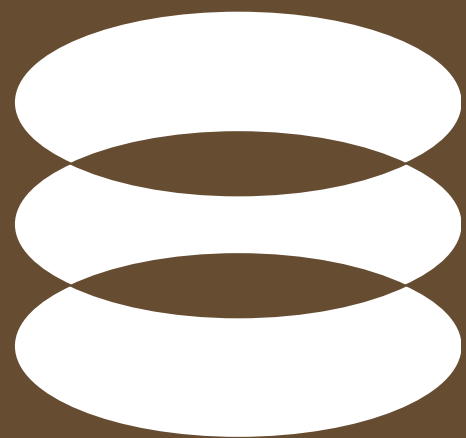
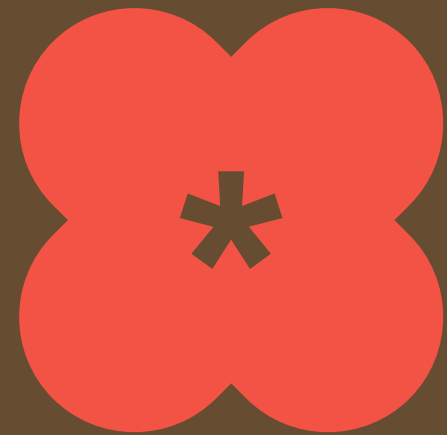
