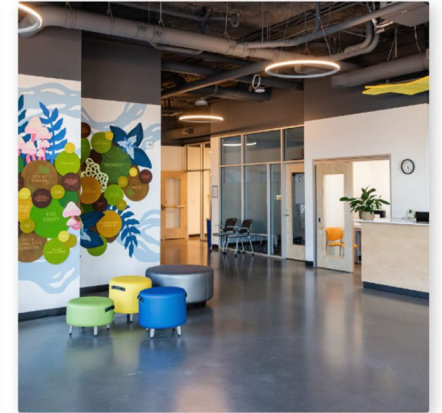

No matter if it's a small meeting, group training, workshop or community gathering; Together Center has a variety of spaces for 501(c)3 nonprofits to host their meetings and events.

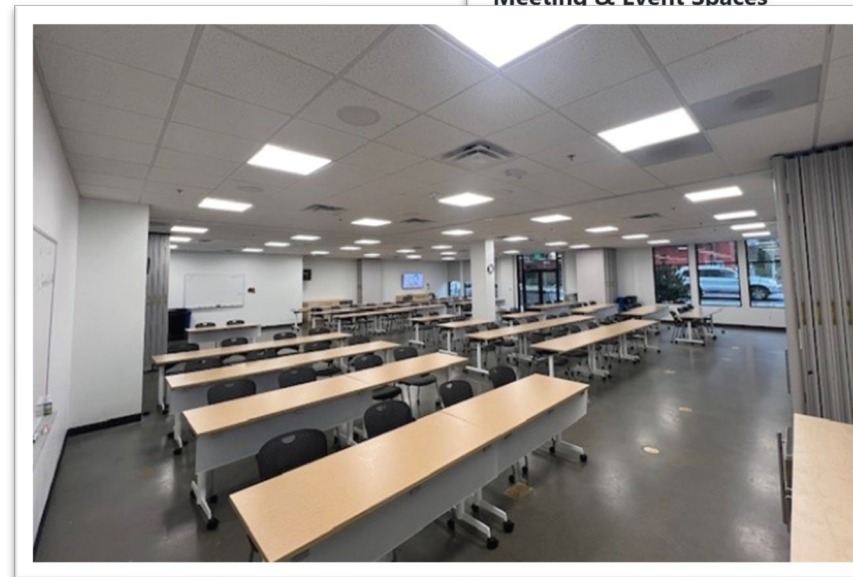
